State Legislature Passes Vote Center Bill

On February 8th, Governor Mitch Daniels signed Senate Bill 32 which establishes the use of vote centers as an option for all counties in Indiana. Vote Centers offer a more flexible way for voters to cast their ballots on Election Day and will save the taxpayers thousands of dollars. With Vote Centers, voters can select the most convenient polling place for them to vote on Election Day, whether that location is near home, work, school or the grocery store. Unfortunately, the Vote Center legislation, like Satellite Voting, requires **unanimous** approval of the County Election Board. Based on comments made by Denny Sullivan at the February 8 Election Board Meeting, the Democrats will continue to deny the voters of Warrick County increased access to voting options, and block the use of Vote Centers in Warrick County.
