Phone Banks – This week we started making phone calls to registered voters in Warrick County urging them to get out and vote Republican on November 2nd! Door-to-Door Campaigning – There are only 4 Saturdays left until the election. For well over a month now, our candidates have been going door-to-door to appeal to voters. A final push before the election is essential to our efforts. At the September breakfast meeting we asked each precinct committeemen to commit to 3 hours of his/her time between now and the election and knock on doors in his/her precinct. Several have already answered this call to action, but we need more participation. Election Day – Many volunteers will be needed to coordinate election day efforts. We are in the process of recruiting poll book holders to work at some of the larger polling places. The poll book holders will be responsible for checking the list of persons voting at that location and reporting back to HQ periodically. Volunteers at HQ will be needed to phone those Republican voters who have not voted and get them to the polls. We need approximately 60 poll book holders to work at the polls. The positions pay \$50 for the day. Hours will be from 6:00am to 3:00pm. Satellite Voting Blocked by Democrats!

The Warrick County Election Board met on September 16th to address several issues pertaining to the upcoming general election, including a resolution to provide Satellite Voting locations in Newburgh and Lynnville. The resolution, which required unanimous approval of the board, was defeated when Don Lee, the representative for the Warrick County Democrat Party, voted against the resolution. Board President Bernie Montgomery, a Republican appointee to the board, and Clerk Sarah Topper vote in favor of the resolution. The resolution, if passed, would have made the Ohio Township Central Library and the Lynnville Community Center available for voters to cast their ballots at those locations on October 19, 21, 26 & 28 from noon until 6:00pm. One person, Bob Gober, appeared before the election board to voice opposition to the resolution, and expressed concern over the cost to operate the satellite locations. Several individuals supportive of the resolution, including Warrick County Republican Chairman Rick Martin, appeared at the meeting and addressed the board. Martin countered Gober's cost concerns by pointing out that, in the Spring, the Clerk had advised that the cost to operate the Lynnville Satellite Office would amount to less than \$1,000 and the cost to operate the Newburgh Satellite Office would be similar. Martin said that "[w]e need to be smart with our spending and cut wasteful items such as the duplication of poll workers on election day, so that we can spend taxpayer dollars on things like satellite voting that truly benefit the taxpayer." After the meeting, Chairman Martin expressed his disappointment in the decision of the election board. "It seems like the Warrick County Democrats don't want the voter's to come to the polls and vote this fall. It's a shame that the Democrat Party chooses to stand in the way of progress and is denying the voters of Warrick County access to satellite voting that was wildly successful in 2008 and will be available to voters in Vanderburgh County this fall." Do not be deterred by the efforts of the Democrats to stop you from voting! Come out and vote Republican on November 2nd.

Clerk's Office Open for Early Voting!

The Warrick County Clerk's Office in the Judicial Center in Boonville is open for Absentee-In-Person Voting, AKA Early Voting from now until Monday November 1st from 8am to 4pm. On Wednesdays (October 13th, 20th, 27th) they will be open until 6pm. They will also be open on Saturday October 23rd and October 30th from 8am to 3pm. No reason for voting early is needed, just show up and vote. Please remember to bring your photo ID and leave any metal items in your vehicle as you will have to go through security. Avoid lines on election day and make your vote count.
