The Warrick County Election Board is scheduled to meet at 6:00 pm on Thursday September 16<sup>th</sup> to consider a number of issues, including the use of the Newburgh/Ohio Township Central Library and Lynnville Community Center as Satellite Voting Locations for the 2010 General Election. This proposal was voted down by Democrat Board Member Denny Sullivan in March for the primary election. This is a very important issue for the voters of Warrick County and we encourage you to attend the meeting and make your voice heard. The meeting will take place in the Commissioner's Meeting Room in the Old Courthouse on the Square in Boonville.
